Government Requirements

- **Event Participants**
- The IECN assists event participants by offering free advice on Australian visas.
- **Do I require a visa?**
- All visitors to Australia must have a valid visa before boarding their plane regardless of the length of stay.
- **Note:** New Zealand and Norfolk Island passport holders do not usually need to lodge a visa application prior to their departure unless they have health and/or character concerns.
- The IECN can advise you on the following:
 - how to apply for a visa
 - what visa to apply for
 - when to apply for a visa
 - where to apply for a visa.

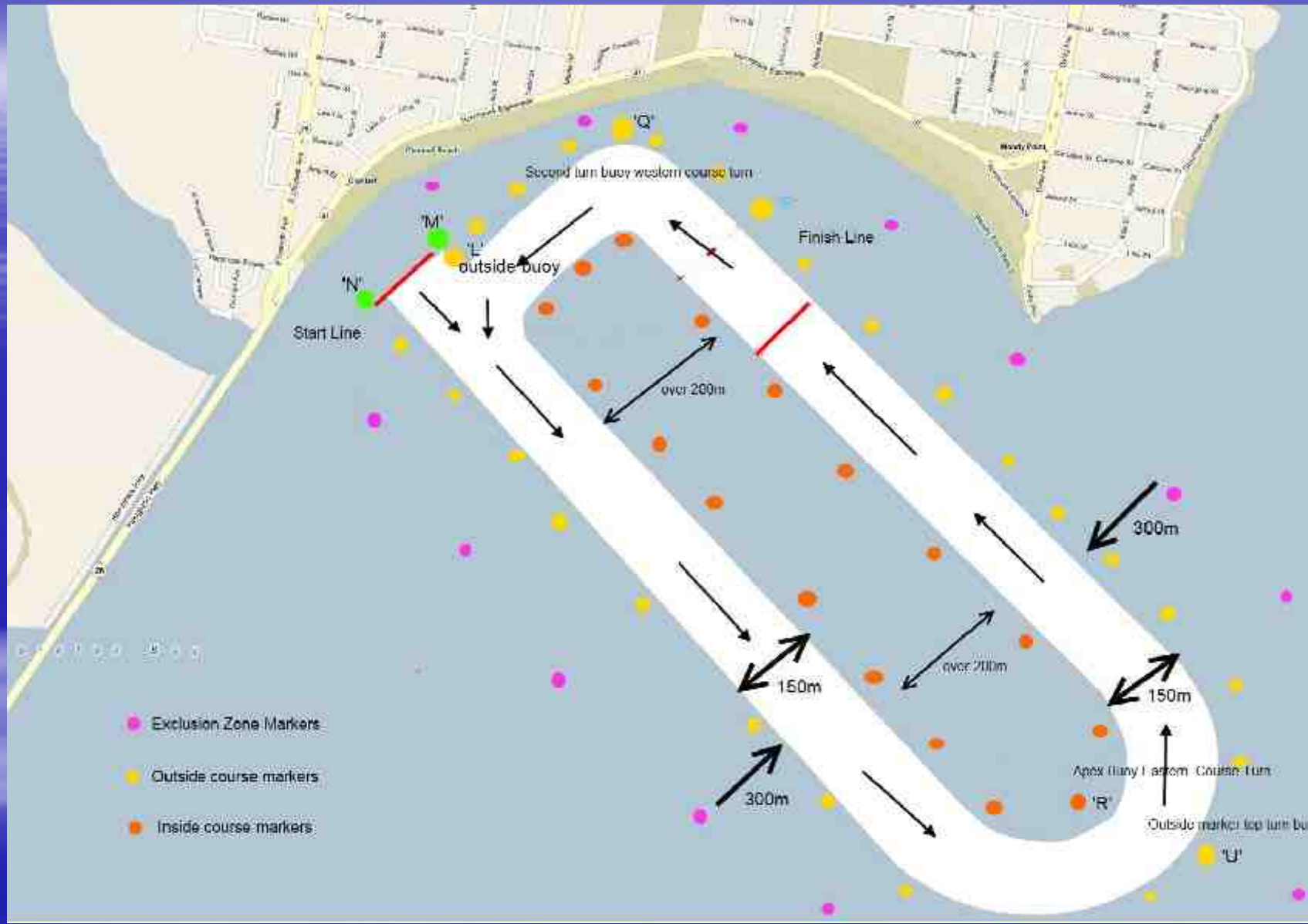
- If you are not from an eVisitor or ETA eligible country, ensure you obtain a confirmation of your registration, or a letter of invitation, to attach to your paper-based visa application.
- Lodge paper-based visa applications at the Australian visa office nearest to your current country of residence.

- **Important:** IECN assistance will not guarantee a visa grant. In order to be granted a visa you must meet all the legislative requirements of that visa.
- **Confidentiality**
- In accordance with Australia's *Privacy Act 1988*, any information an event organiser or participant passes on to the Department's IECN, will only be used to facilitate visa processing with the relevant Australian overseas visa

Secured Parking

- FREE secured parking will be provided for all race boats. This area will be not be under cover but will be patrolled by security guards at no cost to competitors.
- Lock up site garages can be hired from the organising committee.
- The cost to hire a site garage for the week is:
 - Standard 3m x 6m garage space = \$650 AUS*
 - Premium 6m x 6m Pit Garage = \$2,000 AUS*

- **Season Spring Average Temperatures**
- **12C to 23C (54F to 73F) Possible Extreme Temperatures**
