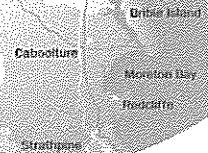

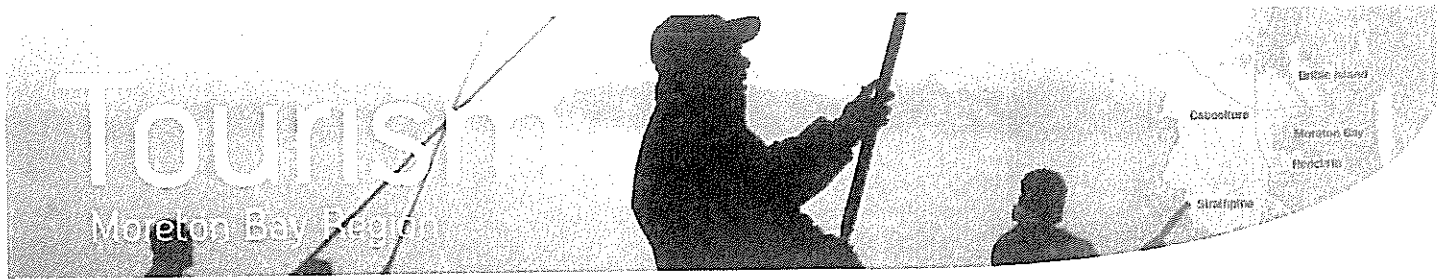

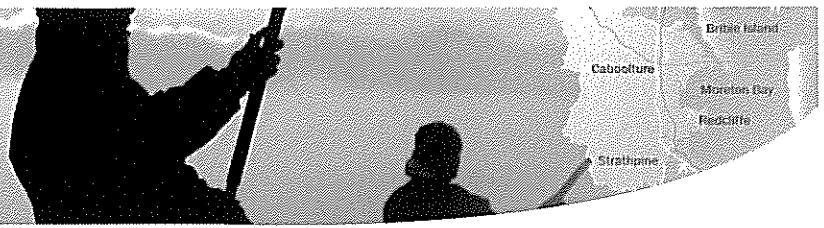

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## One day in Redcliffe

### 8am – Relax with breakfast by the ocean

To start the day, why not visit one of Redcliffe's foreshore coffee shops or cafes which also offer superb views of Moreton Bay at no extra charge. It's a relaxing start to what promises to be a memorable day!

### 9.30am – The sky's the limit

Get a bird's eye appreciation of Redcliffe whilst enjoying a tandem parachute jump, you will touch down on one of the beautiful beaches.

### 11am – Beach Fun

After the rigours of skydiving what better way to unwind than a leisurely dip just metres from where you landed. There are several foreshore wonderlands just waiting to be explored.

### 11.45am – Garden Tour

Redcliffe's Botanic Gardens in Henzell Street provides a chance to get in touch with nature. ## The History

Redcliffe, Queensland's first settlement site has a rich and varied history.

Before European settlement in 1824, the area now known as Redcliffe was inhabited by Aborigines who took full advantage of the foods that could be easily found in and around its waters.

The settlement of Redcliffe (so named because of the distinctive red cliff faces) by the early Europeans was directly linked to Australia's convict heritage. Redcliffe, situated on the edge of Moreton Bay, was considered to be the best location for a new northern penal settlement.

The brig Amity set sail for Redcliffe from Sydney on September 1, 1824 carrying settlement commandant Lieutenant Miller, explorer John Oxley, crew and convicts. The party landed at Redcliffe on September 13, 1824.

When the decision was made to relocate the settlement to the banks of the Brisbane River in 1825, Redcliffe was deserted and remained so until the 1860s when the area was declared an Agricultural Reserve. The land was used for dairying, sugarcane, wheat, cotton, beef, honey, cattle feed, oranges and potatoes.

Redcliffe underwent a significant land boom in the 1880s. At this time the area was quickly gaining a reputation as a seaside resort – offering a coastal experience similar to many of the holiday destinations in England. A growing number of people were lured to Redcliffe to enjoy its safe, sheltered sandy beaches.

Day bathers travelled to the peninsula by steamer – the most celebrated being the Koopa. The Koopa delivered its first passengers to the Redcliffe Jetty in 1911 and continued to transport tourists to the peninsula until World War II – when it was requisitioned by the Royal Australian Navy.

Improved roads and the construction of the 2.8 kilometre Hornibrook Highway, which was officially opened on Friday, October 4, 1935, allowed more and more people to experience the magic of Redcliffe. The bridge meant Redcliffe was no longer considered isolated – and as a result local population increased significantly.

The Houghton Highway, a bridge duplicating the Hornibrook Highway, was officially opened on December 20, 1979.

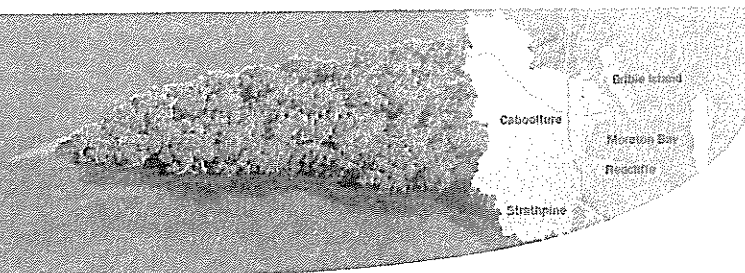
Today, Redcliffe is part of a modern region that still possesses the charm and beauty of a small seaside holiday town. The mix of old and new continues to make the region so inviting to locals and visitors alike.

## Touring Redcliffe

Redcliffe is a picturesque seaside suburb, just north of Brisbane that offers plenty of attractions for both locals and visitors. Redcliffe and its surrounds offer a huge array of activities, including whale watching, skydiving, boating and cycling – and there are also plenty of cultural experiences to savour.

Getting to Redcliffe is easy. The Bruce Highway provides the main northern link to Redcliffe via Deception Bay while the Houghton Highway provides the southern link via the Gateway Arterial Road. Regular bus services connect with rail services at Sandgate and several bus services also connect to the Brisbane CBD via Brisbane's northern suburbs. The Peninsula also has Taxis services that operate 24 hours a day and a airfield to cater for light aircraft.

### Walking Tours

Redcliffe boasts 22km of stunning coastline which can be easily explored on foot.

- The Redcliffe Jetty has been the heart of the peninsula for more than 100 years and is a gateway to Moreton Bay. It's an easy 20-minute stroll to the end of the jetty and back and offers spectacular views of Moreton Bay.
- The Hornibrook Highway at Clontarf is 2.8km long and is one of the Southern Hemisphere's longest bridges. No longer open to traffic, it is a haven for pedestrians and cyclists.
- Enjoy a leisurely 2km walk along the timber boardwalk at picturesque Margate Beach.

### Cycling Tour

Redcliffe boasts an extensive bikeway network with more than 35km of dedicated bikeways most of which hug the peninsula's mostly flat coastline and offer fabulous views of the bay.

### Whale Watching Tour

Whale watching is a popular activity for visitors to Redcliffe. Moreton Bay provides the ideal vantage point to see these wonderful creatures up close during their annual migration from June to November. For more information call Moreton Bay Whale Watching on 3880 0477.

### Skydiving

If you like action and adrenalin then your first stop should be Suttons Beach where you will be transferred to the Redcliffe Aerodrome for a tandem parachute jump which lands right on the beach. While your experienced instructor guides you back to earth, you will enjoy the magnificent views from Noosa to the Gold Coast and across to Moreton Bay and the Glass House Mountains. 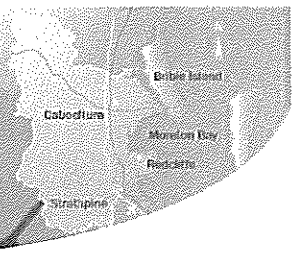

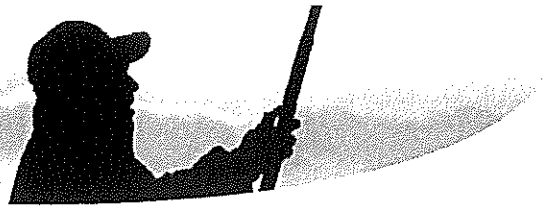
