# **PROCEDURES & PROTOCOLS FOR IMPORTING USED EQUIPMENT INTO AUSTRALIA**

**JANUARY 2011**

**As Australia is an island country the restrictions imposed on people importing ANY USED equipment into the country are very stringent.**

**Australia has primarily two Government Departments that monitor and oversee these processes, they are ACS (Australian Customs Service) and AQIS (Australian Quarantine Inspection Services.)**

**Any goods that are imported into Australia are subject to the rules and regulations of these departments.**

**ACS, is primarily set up to ensure that the correct importing procedures have taken place, revenue control by way of GST and or duty and the importation of illegal goods.**

**AQIS, is set up to monitor and stop any contaminated materials entering Australia, this includes contaminated**

**plants, soils, shells, water, etc. These contaminants are generally found on/in used equipment. Therefore the Australian Government has strict rules on any used equipment entering its shores. All used equipment once declared through to the ACS will be subject to AQIS inspections. These inspections MUST be carried out at an AQIS approved inspection depot. You are unable to access your equipment until it has been approved by AQIS to be moved and taken into general circulation within Australia.**

**If your equipment is in a container, the whole container will be required to be taken to the AQIS depot, completely unpacked, inspected, cleaned at the depot if required and then re-inspected for its final approval. If you were wanting the container then to go to the race site it would need to be repacked and then delivered to site.**

**Please note that individual owners are not able to unpack containers in AQIS depots, this is to be done by AQIS trained or approved warehouse staff and is completely at the cost of the importer. These costs can range into \$1000 - \$2000 AUD, firm quotes should be obtained prior to shipping.**

**Please note, that depending on the work load of the AQIS depots that cleaning delays of up to 2-3 weeks cannot be uncommon.**

The above rules and regulations also apply to any cargo that maybe entering the country “roro” roll on roll of. This equipment needs to be towed from the wharf and then taken to an AQIS depot for the same procedures as above. Further information about these laws can be found at [www.infrastructure.gov.au/](http://www.infrastructure.gov.au/) then click into vehicle imports. Boats and Trailers are considered vehicles in Australia.

When arranging your shipping, ensure that your shipping line or forwarding agent is completely aware of these regulations as these delays could hold your boat and you could miss the World Championships. I expressly agree that the foregoing release, waiver, and indemnity agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the laws of **Australia** in which the event is conducted as well as the laws of any jurisdiction from which a participating federation is domiciled and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

**I AGREE** to abide by the Rules of the International Water Ski Federation ("IWSF") and the **Ski Racing Australia Incorporated ("SRA")** including any additions or amendments thereto AND FURTHER **AGREE to comply with all instructions given by the IWSF, SRA and the Organisers of the Championships.**

**I ACKNOWLEDGE** and agree that I fully accept responsibility and liability for any act or activities of myself during the Championships and am involved in the Championships at my own risk. I HEREBY RELEASE, WAIVE, DISCHARGE and COVENANT not to sue in any jurisdiction, the IWSF, the **SRA** the Organisers or their respective officials, servants, representatives or agents, individually or collectively, and fellow competitors from or for any and all liability to me for all loss or damage for bodily injury, death or damage to property as a result of my competing and/or practicing, officiating, observing, working for, or otherwise participating in the Championships howsoever arising notwithstanding that the same may have been contributed to or occasioned by the negligence of the said persons, bodies, their officials, servants, representatives or agents.

**Notwithstanding the above, I HEREBY INDEMNIFY the IWSF, SRA and the Organisers of the Championships together with their respective officials, servants, representatives or agents from and against any actions, claims, costs, expenses and demands in respect of death, injury, loss of, or damage to the person and/or property of myself, my driver(s), my skier(s), my observer(s) or any other person as the case may be arising out of or in connection with my competing and/or practicing, officiating, observing, working for, or otherwise participating in the Championships howsoever arising notwithstanding that the same may have been contributed to or occasioned by the negligence of the said persons, bodies, their officials, servants, representatives or agents.**

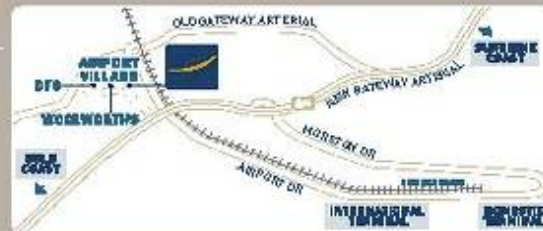
